COUNCIL RECOMMENDATION ON VET FOR SUSTAINABLE COMPETITIVENESS, SOCIAL FAIRNESS AND RESILIENCE (2020)

- to make sure VET equips young people and adults with the skills to support both the recovery and the green and digital transitions, while ensuring inclusiveness.
- By 2025 the following EU-level objectives:
 - the share of employed graduates from VET should be at least 82 %;
 - 60 % of recent graduates from VET benefit from exposure to work-based learning during their vocational education and training. 8 % of learners in VET benefit from a learning mobility abroad
